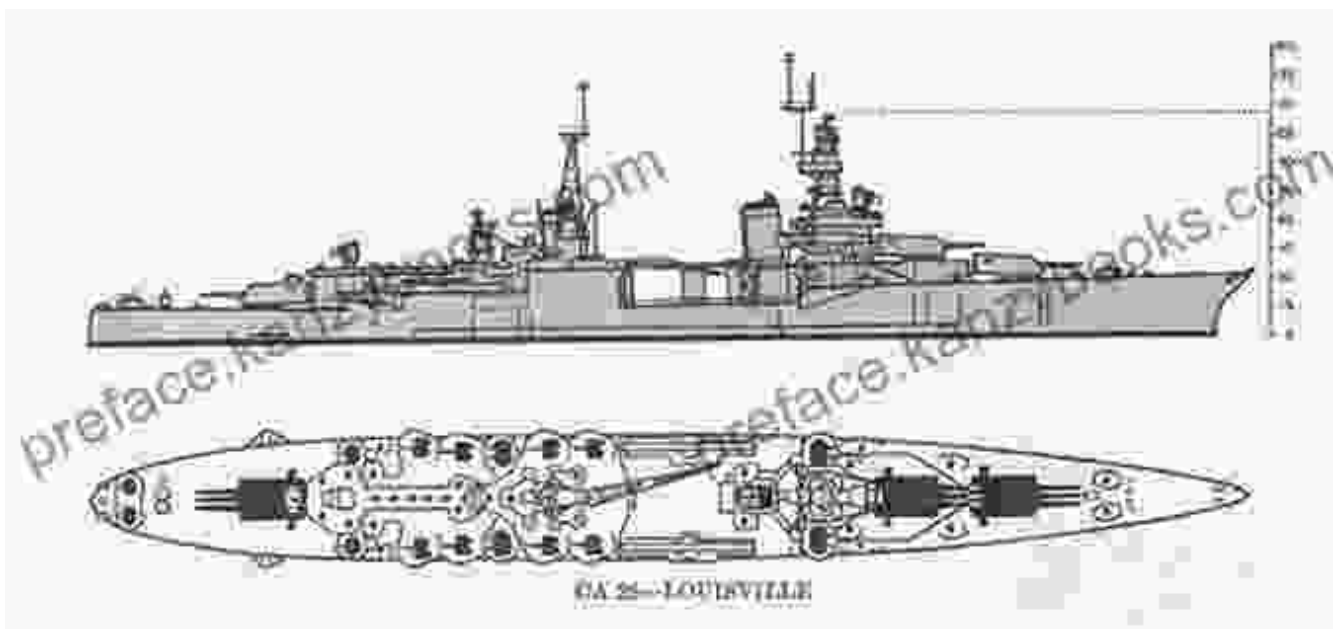


# The Mighty Northampton Class: America's Heavy Cruisers in World War II

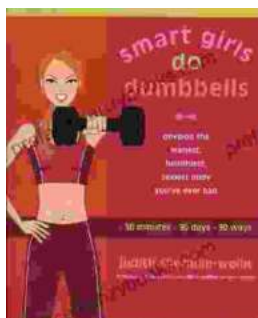

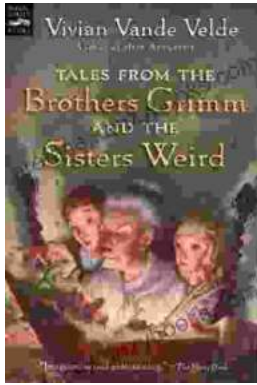
